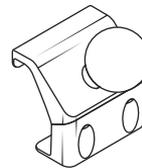

WARNINGS

- Do not mount accessories in front of or near the path of airbag deployment.
- Check vehicle compatibility before install to avoid damage to the vehicle mount point.
- Designed to work with OEM dashboard only, not compatible with aftermarket modifications.
- Do not use with 3rd party extension arms. Adhere to our phone weight limits.
- Mount electronics away from airflow to prevent heat damage.

Using the L-key provided, slightly loosen the screws to ensure the inner plate moves.

Do not fully remove the screws - keep about one thread engaged.

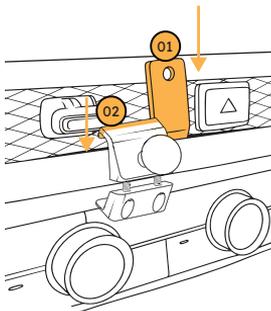

Insert the trim tool to the depth shown between the mesh and bezel to create a gap (01).

Insert the upper mounting base plate tab into that gap (02).

Remove trim tool.

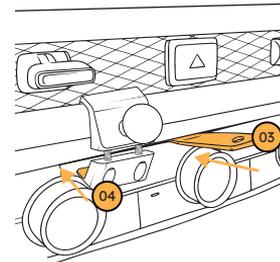

Insert the trim tool to the depth shown into the upper portion of the A/C module to create a gap (03).

Insert the lower mounting base plate tab into that gap (04).

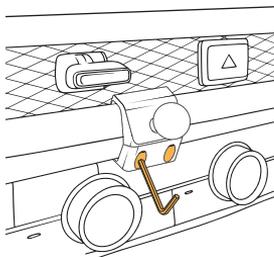
Remove trim tool.

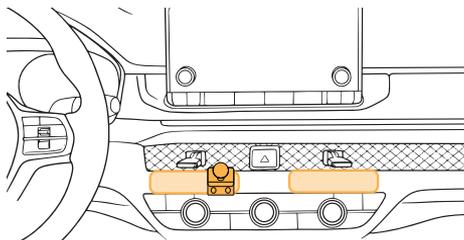
Using the L-key, hand tighten the screws until the mounting base has a snug fit.

To ensure the best fit possible, hold mounting base while tightening.

Fits in the areas as shown. Do not mount below hazard light button.
